ONE MONTH BEFORE MOVING

- Hold a moving/garage sale or donate items to charities.
- Start a box for any items you wish to donate before moving.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Cable/Satellite Service.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Electricity Services.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Garbage Collections Service.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Gas Company Services.
- Call to arrange a start date and stop for Telephone Services.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Water Services.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Newspaper.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Grocery Delivery.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Lawn Maintenance.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for Pool Maintenance.
- Call to arrange a start and stop date for House Cleaning.
- Send notification of change of address for billing to Cellular Phone Provider.
- Pay any bills or place them in your to-go-box.
- Do you need to set up boarding for your family pets?

- Do you need to make baby sitting arrangements?
- Send your new address to anyone that might need it -- insurance agents, credit card companies, magazine subscriptions, friends, relatives, etc.

ONE WEEK BEFORE MOVING

- Change your address online in a matter of minutes with <https://moversguide.usps.com/> this service is free, quick and easy to use.
- Empty fuel or other hazardous chemicals from any items that will be moved (ie. Lawnmower).
- Defrost clean and dry out your refrigerator and freezer 24 hours before the day of your move. Add a deodorizer.
- Use up food items.
- Clean rugs and clothing.
- Don't miss trash day.
- Return borrowed items: library books, movies and personal borrowed items

PACK A TO-GO-BOX

(Items you can not do without for the next two days.)

- Set aside valuable items to carry with you including jewelry, vital documents, money and valuable small items.

- Pillows
- Tooth Brush/Paste/Floss
- Toiletries
- Medications

- Light Bulbs
- Telephone
- Radio
- Basic Tool Kit

DAY OF MOVE (Leaving previous residence.)

- Take a final reading on the gas, water and electricity meters.
- Turn down the thermostat on the furnace.
- Check to make certain the telephone service has been disconnected.
- Check the basement, attic, storage shed and each room for missed items.
- Check all closets, drawers, cupboards and crawl spaces.
- Make certain all of the windows are closed and locked.
- Turn off all of the lights.
- Leave all keys on the counter or with the real estate agent.
- Leave the garage door openers on the counter.
- Leave all appliance operating manuals on the counter.
- Empty the garbage.
- Close and lock all of the doors.
